UNIVERSITY GUEST RESIDENT PROGRAM RATES & ACCOMMODATIONS

Nightly accommodations are available in the UC Davis residence halls for official adult guests of UC Davis. Housing space on campus is limited, so timely submission of a reservation form will assure lodging.

Guest Resident accommodations are located in Primero Grove, an apartment-style residential complex on the north side of campus. Primero Grove offers a clean and comfortable style of accommodation with basic amenities that include daily bed making, towel exchange, wireless internet access and telephone service. A calling card or prepaid phone card will be needed to place long distance phone calls. Each bedroom is furnished with a double size bed which is prepared with fresh linens upon your arrival. Apartments with multiple bedrooms will share bath facilities.

DINING

Daily breakfast is provided with your accommodations. You can purchase additional single meals at the door or multiple meals through the Sodexo office. Meals are professionally prepared and served platform style in the Segundo dining room. The menu offers a wide variety of hot and cold entrees, a vegetarian entree, extensive salad and sandwich bars, soups, fresh fruits, desserts and beverages. Guests are welcome to return for additional servings as often as they wish.

INTERNET ACCESS

PARKING

Primero Grove guests should park in Visitor Parking lot VP22 or VPI7. There is a charge of \$6 each weekday. Permits can be purchased at parking lot permit dispensers. Parking rates are subject to increase July 1. Short term visitor permits are available through Transportation & Parking Services [taps.ucdavis.edu].

GUARANTEED RESERVATIONS

Reservations will be made on a first come, first served basis and cannot be guaranteed until payment is received. Rooms will be guaranteed only when full payment is received in advance. All charges must be paid in US currency and drawn on a US bank. Traveler's checks, cashier's checks, personal checks, money orders and Visa/MasterCard will be accepted. Credit card payments may be accepted by fax. Checks must be made payable to UC Regents.

Conference Housing processes reservations Monday through Friday, 8am-5pm. If your reservation form is received on a weekend or holiday it will not be processed until the following business day. All reservations must be received 24 business hours prior to your arrival date. To reserve accommodations, please complete the reservation form and send with full payment to the address noted on the form. Upon receipt, we will send your payment receipt and reservation confirmation along with detailed arrival and check-in instructions

CANCELLATIONS

All cancellations must be made at least two weeks prior to the reserved arrival date; a service fee of \$25 will be deducted from the refund amount. A refund check will be mailed approximately four to six weeks after notification.
